Acrostic Poem Adjective Word List A – awesome, amiable, alive, artistic B – brilliant, bold, brave, bright C – creative, cool, calm, cute, crazy An acrostic poem is a poem where certain letters in each line spell out a word or phrase. Typically, the first letters of each line are used to spell the message, but they can appear anywhere. A poem where the first letter of each line and the last letter of each line spell out words is called a double acrostic. An acrostic is a poem (or other forms of writing) in which the first letter (or syllable, or word) of each line (or paragraph, or other recurring feature in the text) spells out a word or a message. We shared below the ones that we like most. Abecedarian: Acrostic in which alphabets are spelled instead of words. Chaucer's poem "La Priere de Nostre Dame" is a good example of an abecedarian acrostic. Non-Standard: Non-standard acrostics do not use first or last letters to spell out a word. Instead, they emphasize letters in different places within the poem.
