Nikon 85mm f/1.4G. The 85mm is among the best Nikon lenses for portraits for many reasons. First is its ideal focal length. It allows you to take tight shots of the face without visible distortion. It also allows you to be far enough from your subject and still achieve intimate results. Nikon camera image sensors. Nikon FX lenses work best with Nikon DSLR cameras with a full-frame image sensor measuring roughly 36mm x 24mm – the same dimensions as a frame of 35mm film. This is the largest sensor on a digital camera made for consumers. Though Nikon still produces an autofocus version of this lens, the manual-focus version (which was axed in 2006) has far superior optical quality. When used as a portrait lens, the 85mm f/1.4 AI-S produces beautiful bokeh and is a favorite lens of many loyal Nikon shooters.
