The AAMC has testing limits on how many times you can take the MCAT exam. Voids and no-shows count toward your lifetime limits. Remember that you can only be registered for one seat at a time. The MCAT exam can be taken up to 3 times in a single testing year and up to 4 times in a 2 consecutive-year period. When to take the MCAT. The best time to take the MCAT is the year before you intend to start medical school. Additionally, it's best to begin planning your test prep about three to five months before your MCAT test date. Kaplan recommends between 300 and 350 hours of total MCAT test prep.
