Drivers on Nevada roads have two new laws starting July 1. The updated law becomes effective July 1, 2017. Drivers found guilty of violating the law can be charged with a misdemeanor. Nevada joins Arkansas, Colorado, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Vermont and Washington, which also adopted social media privacy laws this year, and California, Illinois, Maryland, and Michigan, which did so in 2012.
