What are the Northern Lights. At some point in our lives, each of us has either heard stories about or seen images of dancing lights in the far north of our planet. To capture the aurora, Goodwin recommends that fellow photo buffs try a five-night road trip from Spokane to northern Idaho and Montana, then back to Washington State. “If we were writing up a travel brochure for aurora hunters coming to Spokane,” Goodwin says, “I would recommend a loop drive from Spokane to Priest Lake, Idaho, and then to Lake McDonald at Glacier National Park in Montana.
